The objective of the Oresund Security Day is to increase the scientific interaction in security in the Oresund region. The workshop will provide a platform for exchange of ideas, discussion and co-operation among the research groups that focus on security in the Oresund area. It will provide the opportunity to meet one another, create an environment for joint work, and strengthen the visibility of security research in Scandinavia.

The workshop is an unique occasion to listen to talks about cool and cutting-edge research results in different areas of computer security. Topics of interest include, but are not limited to:
